ACCIDENTS	BY LAW all accidents must be reported. There is a book for this purpose in the Hide.
VISITORS USING THE SITE SAFELY	Farnham Gravel Pits is managed for nature conservation interests. Visitors are requested: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To remember that footpaths can be uneven or occasionally slippery. Rabbit holes can be a problem.</li><li>• To please stay on marked paths</li><li>• To wear suitable clothing and footwear for the terrain and weather</li><li>• Do not enter the water</li><li>• To leave the site immediately if there is any sign of potentially dangerous conditions such as stormy weather.</li></ul>
Disabled Access	The paths through the site are mainly mown grass and subject to damage by rabbits making them difficult for wheelchair users.
